The wide bullnose verandah gives a welcoming first impression. The owners tell us this is the best spot on a winter morning to enjoy a cup of coffee and the morning sun.

The original structure has been added to over the years to create a larger family home, now comprising 5 bedrooms (or 4 plus an office). 4 of the bedrooms have built-in robes, and the master bedroom also has an adjoining room that could be utilised as your own sitting room, dressing room, or office.

Multiple living areas ensure there is somewhere for each member of the family to relax. The front lounge room is perfect for sitting by the warmth of the wood heater and catching up on your favourite shows. Second living room offers plenty of space to settle in and spread out, and has a built-in desk for a home office area, craft space or homework zone.

Open plan kitchen and dining is centrally positioned between both the lounge rooms. Blending original features with modern conveniences, this kitchen contains an antique wood combustion stove, electric oven and cooktop, functional bench space, and an abundance of storage cupboards.
